Georgian Court University (GCU) located in Lakewood, New Jersey is set on a beautiful estate formerly owned by financier George Jay Gould. The campus is 60 miles from New York and Philadelphia, and only 10 miles from the Jersey Shore. GCU supports a unique college experience where students can enjoy a small college ambiance in a beautiful university setting.

GCU secured a \$7.5 million bonding package to support construction activities that will have a positive impact on the campus student. Aramark Engineering Solutions was selected to develop and review strategic plans that outlined areas of immediate focus including façade remediation, storm water management, environmental management, and other related projects that will occur over the initial 1-3 years. The project outcomes will minimize disruptions on campus and support cashflow management.
